1. The Company

EPI Company ("EPI") is a Europese vennootschap (Societas Europaea) under Belgian law, registered with on the Belgian trade and companies register under number CBE 0755.811.726, with its registered headquarters at ,De Lignestraat 13, 1000 Brussels, Belgium. EPI is licensed as of date 20 February 2024 license with National Bank Belgium as a PISP and AISP for services 7 (payment initiation services and 8 account information services) under the license number 0755.811.726. This regulatory status give EPI the authorization as a payment institution also grants EPI a recognized status within the Member States of the European Union; this status authorizes EPI to carry out its business in all Member States (subject to informing the NBB beforehand).

2. Operation, host, design, and implementation
